Ergonomic Handle Package

The handle thickness and angled shape were chosen to provide the most fatigue-free operation. A few strokes of the large steering handle result in 5" of lift, while loads can be quickly deposited by pulling the convenient three-position lever. The neutral position eliminates back pressure from the pump allowing the operator to handle the load rather than fight the truck. In addition, the handle is spring-loaded so that it will return to a vertical position when released.

Articulated Steer Wheels

Crown manufactures the steer and load wheels because these components are critical to durability, as well as handling and control. The 7" steer wheels improve handling and control, while articulated wheels ensure continual contact with the floor, which is especially important on uneven surfaces.

Low Rolling Resistance

High quality compounds and bearings are used to lower rolling resistance, provide longer wear and ensure smooth and quiet operation.

Crown Built Durability

The PTH 50 Series has all the right answers to the question of durability. Durability starts with a deep, low-profile frame cross brace between the forks and continues with the steel forgings used on the lift link arms. Its hydraulic unit is built to withstand thousands of lift/lower cycles. The bushings in the lift structure of the PTH 50 Series are of the same durable design used in all Crown trucks, a Teflon-impregnated bronze with steel backing. Even the hub cap enhances overall durability, protecting the bearing and steer axle from side impact damage.

5000 lb Capacity

Go ahead and load it up. From the innovative strength ridges on the apron to the thick reinforcement on the lower handle, this hand pallet truck is designed to take it.

2.9" Lowered Height

Pallet entry is improved with forks that can be lowered to 2.9". Non-standard pallets become a non-issue.

Dual Entry/Exit System

Dual systems that combine rollers and ramps are provided for both pallet entry and exit. The metal ramps allow the pallet boards to slide onto the rollers which in turn ensures that the PTH 50 Series will virtually glide in and out of any pallet.

Box-Section Style Push Rods

The application of box-section style push rods, which are stronger and more durable than other

push rod designs, also demonstrates Crown's commitment to reliability.

C-Channel Design of Forks

For maximum strength, forks are made from C-channel-design formed steel with steel reinforcing members at key stress areas. Standard fork lengths are available from 36" to 72", and other lengths are available. Overall length is only another 14", which gives these trucks excellent maneuverability in smaller spaces.

The design starts with a strong, robust frame and linkages. It then incorporates a high level of serviceability to simplify maintenance and prolong equipment life.


The Crown PTH 50 Series features extensive use of bushings and bearings that are sealed for life, which eliminates all but one grease zerk. Other hand pallet trucks feature grease zerks that require frequent

maintenance and close attention. And, unlike other hand pallet trucks that require complete replacement of failed hydraulic units, the Crown PTH 50 Series has accessible parts that can easily be maintained. PTH 50 Series

Optional

Skid Adaptor – Increases lowered height to 5.5" to permit skid handling. Raised height increases to 10.5". Adaptor latches in vertical position when truck is needed for handling pallets. Available for 20.5" and 27" width models in fork lengths of 36", 42" and 48" only.

Load Backrest – Constructed of 5/16" steel, backrests are available in 48" and 60" sizes. Bolt-on installation allows them to be retrofitted to existing PTHs in the field. Aftermarket kits are available from your Crown dealer.
